CavityFree SF is a citywide partnership dedicated to improving oral health for all San Francisco children. Our goal is to reduce oral health issues by: influencing policies that affect our community, providing resources to families and caregivers, and establishing support systems to provide preventive services and treatment.

While progress has been made over recent years to provide more programs and services, high rates of untreated tooth decay continue to be reported. Significant inequalities exist based on race and income.

In 2017, **children of color** were **2-3 times** more likely to experience tooth decay than white children.
